About Qingdao and Tianjin City

Qingdao is a major city in eastern Shandong Province, Eastern China, with a population of over 8.715 million. An important region in Eastern China, Shandong Province has seen substantial change in its economic landscape in recent years. Much of this development has been concentrated in Qingdao. Qingdao has seen rapid development. With an annual growth rate of 18.9 percent in 2006, the city's GDP reached 42.3 billion, ranking first in Shandong Province and tenth out of China's cities.

Tianjin is a metropolis in northern China and one of the five national central cities of the People's Republic of China (PRC). Tianjin's GDP reached 1.12 trillion yuan in 2011, an increase of 16.4 percent over 2010. The city of Tianjin recorded China's highest per-capita GDP with \$13,393, followed by Shanghai with \$12,784 and Beijing with \$12,447, levels on par with some developed countries


